Sate Lilit



One of Balinese's most famous authentic cuisine, Sate Lilit, has a distinctive flavor that comes from its main ingredient, mackerel while its skewers are made from stems of fresh lemongrass. The skewer of sate lilit is flat and wide, allowed the minced meat to stick and settle. Sate lilit is made either from fish, pork, beef, chicken or seafood. When they are cooked together over a fire of coconut husks or charcoal, you will get a marvelous taste. In Balinese and Indonesian, the term lilit means "to wrap around". Kecak Dance

A majestic performance, Kecak dance is performed by a circle of 150 performers percussively chanting 'cak,cak,cak' while moving their hands and arms, creating enchanting melody and moves. The most popular dance performance of Bali, Kecak is an important cultural heritage that depicts the story of Ramayana. Kecak dance performance can be found in Luhur Temple, Ubud, and Garuda WisnuKencana.



Melasti Ceremony

Melasti ceremony has a meaning as a process of purification the inner human and nature, by sweeping the natural waste using the source of living water obtained from the lake and the sea. In the process, participants carrying Pratima along with sesajen, umbrellas, banners, Dewata NawaSanga's weapon, traditional music accompaniment Bleganjur, and wearing a white traditional clothing. This purification ritual is believed by Hindus as a place to purify all the elements in the universe. The ceremony is performed before Nyepi and usually conducted in Sanur Beach, Kuta Beach, Melasti Beach, and Batu Bolong Beach.



Barong Dance

The classic Balinese performance art, Barong dance came from pre-hindu era, narrating the fight between good (dharma) and evil (adharma). The dancers' costumes depict the unique combination of lion, tiger, and cow while its body part is adorned with ornaments made by leather, pieces of mirrors as well as feathers of pandan leaf fibers Barong Dance can be watched in DalemUbud temple and in a number of art studios in Batubulan Village.



ATTRACTION



As the capital of West Java province, Bandung is famous as the city. Flowers, beside their fresh air because of their location surrounded by mountains of various. Aspects are often called a giant story.

Tangkuban Perahu Mountain is located at an altitude of 2084 meters above sea level, It is surrounded by gardens and pine forests which are one of the attractions. The city is also known as Paris van Java. This volcano. The active form of stratovolcano is also located near the hill of Dipterocarp. The Upper Debitrocarb, Montagne, Irikaios forest or mountain forests.

In addition, the main tourist attractions are a nozzle or kawah that does not. Sulfur fumes are still emitted. The Queen of Kawah is one of the largest craters. The most famous in Bandung. The other nozzles are Kawah Opus. And Kawah Dumas. The crater queen can be seen from a higher place with a fence. Wooden for tourist safety. The soil around the nozzle is usually white.

With yellow stones due to sulfur load. It was traditionally reported that the TankopanBerhahu Mountain is associated with the Sangkuriang myth. Who fell in love with his mother Dayang Sumbing. To thwart his son's intention to marry her, Dayang Sumbing stipulated a requirement for Sangkuriang and ordered him to make the boat at night one. 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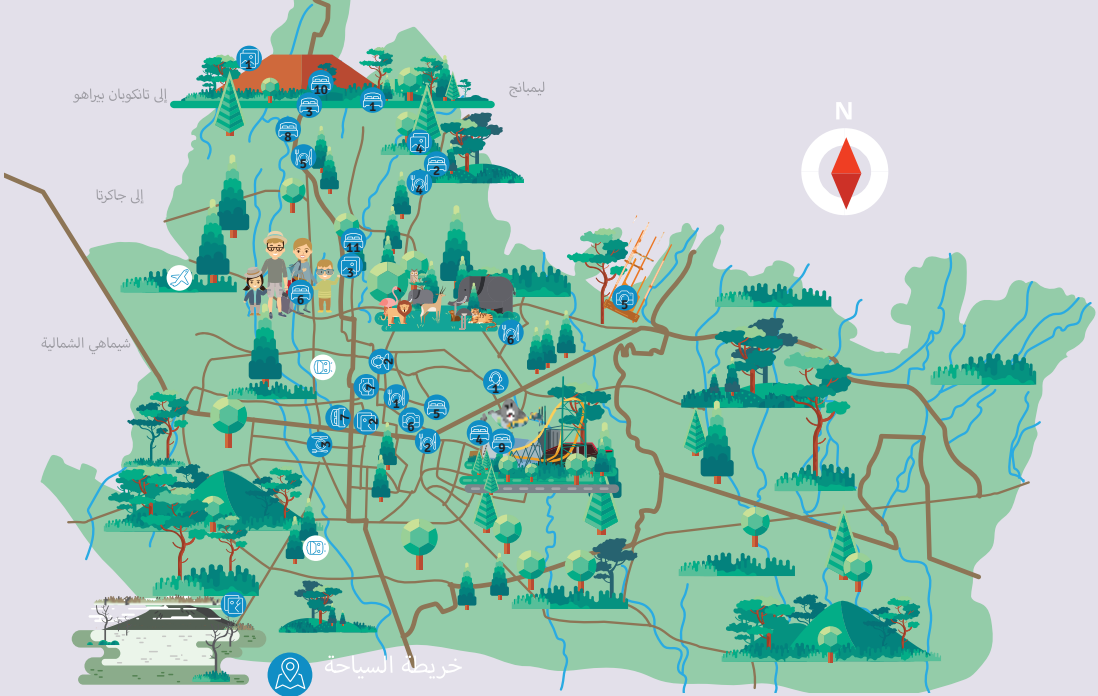

Batagor is an acronym for basotahu goreng (fried tofumeatballs). Generally, this West Java snack is made from tofu that has been softened and filled with dough made from mackerel and tapioca flour, then molded and fried. Batagor served with peanut sauce, sweet soy sauce, sambal, and water from squeeze lemon. Another variation is fried siomay.

Surabi

Surabi is a dish made from pancake-like flour and poured with sweet sauce made from palm sugar. The difference, Surabi is made by burning on the stove and the dough is very thick. The stove is made of clay mold which provides deliciously different flavor. Surabi can be topped with oncom (fermented soybean), jackfruit, cheese, chocolate, banana, sausage, or durian.

This area is made to resemble a ball field with synthetic grass area of 1200 m2 where visitors can be unwind from their daily routine, playing, hanging out or just doing lesehan (sit back and relax). Apart from it, a flower garden is also built full with various colorful flowers. Situated in a strategic location the establishment is also inseparable from the Great Mosque of Bandung which stands majestically near it.



Cihampelas

For shopping enthusiasts, Cihampelas Bandung area is the right location for fashion lover because it's already known as the center of affordable stylish clothing. Initially, Cihampelas Bandung is known as the center of clothing based jeans. However, nowadays a variety of attires and fabrics are offered through various stores and boutiques. Some outlets are decorated strikingly with famous character statues like Spiderman, Superman, Batman and many more. Today, Cihampelas area has become a trendy spot for youngsters with its new construction of Terrace Cihampelas, a skywalk where visitors can find various stalls selling clothes, foods and accessories.



White Crater

Located in the area of Ciwidey, Kawah Putih appear exotic with a lake that was formed by the eruption of Mount Patuha. The crater is located at an altitude of approximately 2,090 mdpl. Asia Africa Conference anniversary

In April, the city of Bandung precisely in Gedung Merdeka, Asia Afrika Street receives guests from various countries to commemorate the Asian-African conference (KAA). The flag raising ceremony of 109 flags of Asian-African countries and the UN became one of the series of events. During the week, the flags fluttered the Asia-African street. Another event is a gala dinner with witnesses of KAA history, gathering until the festival on Sukarno Street. The Asian-African Conference was actually named as Asian-African Summit and also known as the Bandung Conference which first took place between 18 April to 24 April 1955, at Gedung Merdeka, Bandung.

Braga Festival

The festival held at Braga Street and Cikapundung always attracts many visitors. In addition to its location on Braga Street which is known as the old city area in Bandung where along its road you can still see old architectural buildings of the Dutch East Indies with the layout following the existing model in Europe. The Braga Festival involves various street vendors and booths that are dominated by a variety of local cuisine. Besides the delicious food, there are also pop clothing stores, and even tattoo parlour. In addition, at some points you can find the entertainment stage which features music performances and art exhibitions.

Monumen Nasional

The Special Capital Region of Jakarta (DKI Jakarta) is the capital of the Republic of Indonesia. This provincial-level city is the center of business, political and culture visible from the existence of various headquarters of state-owned enterprises, private companies and foreign companies.

The famous 132 meter memorial monument popularly known by public as Monas was established to commemorate Indonesian resistance and struggle to seize independence from the colonial government of Dutch East Indies. Constructed and built during Soekarno's presidency period, the Monument was crowned with gilded flames and surrounded by Indonesia's historical reliefs, gardens, ponds as well as several open fields. At the base of the monument you can also find Indonesian National History Museum. Make sure you pay a visit to the Independence Room where the Republic of Indonesia symbol of the state and independence is kept in reserve. An elevator is also available to bring you to the top of the monument to enjoy the panoramic view of the entire city.

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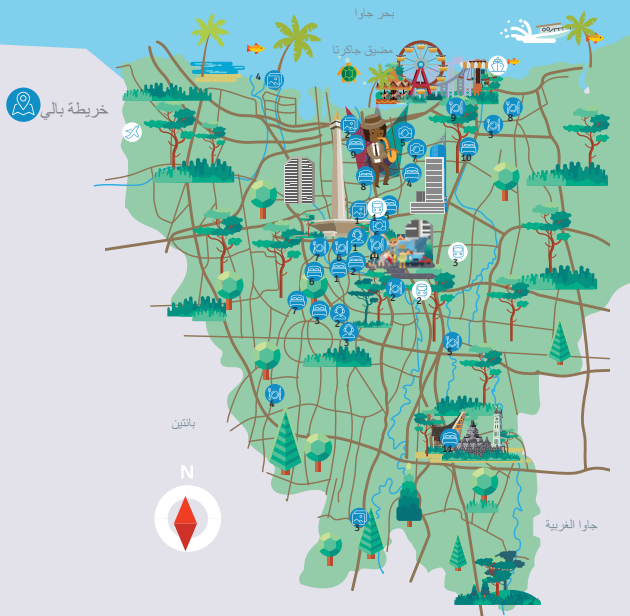

Nasi Uduk

Nasi uduk is a kind of food made from white rice which is mixed and steamed with coconut milk from coconut which is grated, and flavored with nutmeg, cinnamon, ginger lemongrass and pepper. Nasi uduk has a savory taste in the rice due to its cooking process which is mixed with coconut milk. Usually served with tempeorek, fried noodles, fried sambal (hot sauce) with potatoes, balado (spicy marinated) omelet or poached eggs, crackers or fried emping, and fried chicken.

Jakarta Marathon

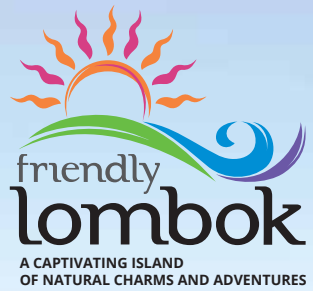

BauNyale

You will be dissolved in the joy with the local community when you participate in this cultural event. The beautiful beach scenery combines with the marvelous phenomenon of marine life. Do not hesitate to immediately add this event into your travel itinerary when you're visiting Lombok in late February or early March. BauNyale is a tradition of catching nyale or sea worms that are routinely done once a year by Lombok locals who live in the south area of the island, especially the WetuTelu disciples. This tradition is associated with the story of Princess Mandalika supposedly contested by many princes and often held in the period of February-March.



Topat War

The Topat War is a ceremony where participants of the event is throwing ketupot (a type of dumpling made from rice packed inside a diamond-shaped container of woven palm leaf pouch) among each other as a gesture of gratitude to the Supreme Lord, for its prosperity in the form of soil fertility, rainwater, and abundant harvest. This ceremony is annually held at Taman Lingsar by the Hindus and the Muslims of Sasak Tribe. The Topat War is usually carried out after the completion of PedandeMapuje, which was at the time of rorokqembong worn (the fall of the hibiscus flowers) at approximately around 17.00 PM.



Mandalika Tour D' Lombok

Most locals, who work as fishermen, will go to the coffee shop, known as Warkop (Warung Kopi), to enjoy a cup of coffee while chatting with their friends until midnight after completing their work. If you want to enjoy the warmth and delicious local coffee, don't forget to visit Warkop and maybe you can also see skilled coffee making techniques!



Splurge on Mie Aceh

Mie Aceh is a noodle dish served with pickled onions, melinjo chips, and cucumber slices. Usually also serves additional dishes, such as shrimp, squid, or beef. Acehnese noodles are usually cooked in three ways : fried, sauteed, and boiled. Every time you go to Aceh, you must stop by in Banda Aceh and visit Mie Razali on Jalan Panglima Polem No. 83-85, Peunayong, Kuta Alam. This restaurant is said to be legendary because it has been operating since 50 years ago. This secret recipe is arguably the most delicious. You can order noodles with optional choices, such as seafood or beef. You can also ask for extra sauce or even without sauce! Even if you want to taste the noodles with sauce or without sauce anything else.

Iboih Beach

Explore the Modest Beauty of Aceh

Iboih Beach is certainly God's creation for sea fans. This beautiful beach is located at the northern end of Pulau Weh, Sabang. Here, you can enjoy a calm atmosphere away from the hustle and bustle of the city. Iboih offers a 'giant aquarium' with colorful corals under the sea - not to mention its local seafood dishes including among the fresh delights in Aceh. There are many ways to enjoy your vacation at Iboih Beach. Among other things snorkeling because Iboih Beach is not only captivating from the surface but also has a beautiful underwater view. You can also take a boat and dive in the waters of the nearby island, Rubiah Island.



The Grand Mosque of Baiturrahman

With its bright white walls and magnificent black dome, this 130-year-old grand mosque is an extraordinary site. The royal scriptures say that the mosque was first built of wood in 1612 under the rule of Sultan Iskandar Muda. Some say that it was built earlier in 1292 by Sultan Alaidin Mahmudsyah. Baiturrahman Grand Mosque is located in the center of the city of Banda Aceh. Characterized by a 35-meter tower, 7 large domes and 7 towers, Baiturrahman is probably the prototype for many mosques in Indonesia and the Malaysian peninsula; replace the layered roof-style mosque.

The Aceh Tsunami Museum

Stepping inside, one will find a narrow corridor with water flowing from both sides accompanied by an eerie roar, reminiscent of the devastation caused by the 2004 tsunami. The museum also features electronic simulations of the Indian Ocean earthquake, images of victims, and stories and testimonies of survivors. The museum building costs around Rp. 70 billion, and consists of 2 floors. The first floor is an open space area that serves as a reminder of the tsunami disaster. The Museum building has adopted the traditional Aceh House which was raised, while at the same time resembling a ship with prominent mouth-pieces.



Takengon

Takengon is a city 100 km from the westernmost tip with a population of no more than 230,000. Takengon is the capital of Central Aceh district. It sits to offer you some rarity that you must see. The food is unique and needs attention. Agro-tourism and activities around Lake LautTawar (freshwater sea) are reasons to extend your stay. Not to mention the legend of a princess who turns to stone with her unseen bodyguards that can be observed. It has a visual concert passing through pine trees, a series of tropical vegetation that is decorated with semi-permanent dwellings, and looks amazed by the local children as your persistent turtles pass through. The breeze will gradually cool down in the fog.



Alas River

The Alas River flows directly into the Indian Ocean; he has amazing rapids that attract rafting fans for the whole world. Located 165 km southeast of Takengon, the Alas River intersects GunungLeuser National Park. This area is very popular with young people and adventurous. Sharp bends and many challenging rapids into the white water basin. Rafting and kayaking are possible on the Alas River from the village of Angasan to the town of Wave, close to the Indian Ocean. Boats pass through pristine rain forests and lots of wildlife can be seen, especially monkeys and various beautiful rich colored birds.



Weh Island

Pulau Weh is naturally untouched despite its small size and easy access. This is another park that is often forgotten. Diving on Weh Island is an established recreational activity. Dive masters and dive instructors are ready to offer various dive sites such as the famous Sea Garden on Rubiah Island. You will find lots of fun sea creatures, especially manta rays, whale sharks, dolphins and turtles. From Banda Aceh, you can take a ferry in the morning at the UleelHeue Sea Port and arrive at Gapang Beach. The trip will only take a few hours, or 45 minutes if you decide to take a speedboat. Or if you are from Medan, you can go to Banda Aceh first by bus or plane



North Sumatra

The booming city of Medan, the capital of North Sumatra, is the economic and commercial center for this region. This is the largest city on the island of Sumatra, which has long attracted residents from all over Indonesia to come and live here. Because of this ethnic diversity, Medan is known for delicious culinary places, rich in many flavors. Mie Gomak is a traditional curry noodle dish from Toba Batak. Mie literally means noodles and Gomak is original for 'digomak', which means preparation by hand. There are two ways to prepare this dish - in broth or fried. This noodle is pale orange in color, quite thick and square in shape. Red curry, flavorful, smooth but not too spicy. This dish is served with spices such as keris (shredded fried coconut) and sambalandaliman (chili sauce made from local Batak pepper) and boiled eggs can sometimes be requested as a topping. The best time to consume Mie Gomak is in cold weather because delicious spices will warm the body.

Lake Toba

Lake Toba is an extraordinary natural wonder in the world. This large crater lake consists of an island almost the size of Singapore in the center. At more than 1,145 square km, and depth of 450 meters, Lake Toba is actually more like the ocean. This is the largest lake in Southeast Asia and one of the deepest lakes in the world. The Orangutan rehabilitation center is a place where orphans are trained to live in the wild and has been operating since 1973. 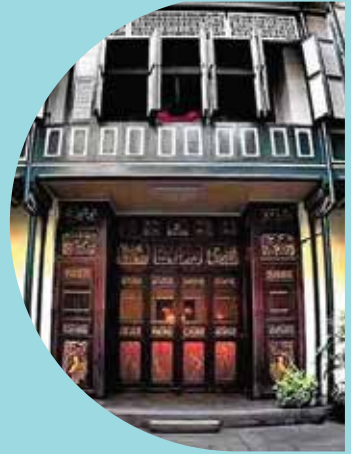
The Maimoon Palace

Tjong A Fie is a Chinese merchant who seeks better wealth in the city now known as Medan. He rose to become a wealthy businessman, respected leader, and philanthropist. With carvings, ornaments, antiques, and beautiful works of art, this large house is dedicated to his beloved wife. Here's a fun fact: Tjong A Fie is among three personalities who funded the construction of the Al Mashun Grand Mosque.



Berastagi

Berastagi The beautiful town of Berastagi in the beautiful Karo highlands, 70 km from Medan to Lake Toba. Located at an altitude of 1,300 meters, the city has a cool climate, ranging from 17-20 degrees Celsius, making a refreshing break from the heat of the city. The day is very pleasant while the night can be very cold. The landscape here is dominated by volcanic views far from Mount Sinabung and Mount Sibayak. On the western edge of the city, Gunaling Hill rises above the surrounding plain to provide some spectacular views of these two towering volcanoes. Berastagi is famous for its flowers, vegetables and fruits and its market is always full of activities.



Mount Sinabung

Traveling to a cool area of fresh air in the highlands is needed to soothe the eyes with an amazing view. Geographically positioned at 3 ° 10' North Latitude and 98 ° 23', 5' East Longitude, Mount Sinabung is located in Karo District, North Sumatra province. The majestic mountain with a height of 2,460 meters high has a total of four volcanic craters. The fertile volcanic soil and cool city temperatures make it ideal for growing fruits, vegetables and flowers. Berastagi flower and fruit market is a colorful paradise of fresh products. You will find exotic fruits and fragrant flowers in dozens of stalls. A fruit and flower festival is held once a year to celebrate the harvest season.

Padeh Acid Meat



It could be said if the city of Padang is a paradise for processing delicious meat. Well, one of the typical foods of West Sumatra that you can taste and comes from processed meat is pandeh meat. As the name implies where the taste of the typical food this one has a spicy taste because it uses a lot of chili and sour taste also comes from kandis acid. At first glance this one is usually similar to Rendang cuisine, it's just that the taste is of course different because rendang does not use kandis acid in the cooking process. Besides this one food is perfect for you to eat in the day with your family.



Payakumbuh

Payakumbuh is the capital city of Limapuluh City. Covering an area of 80,42 square kilometers, the city is recognized as the second largest city after Padang in West Sumatra. The city consists of 3 districts, namely: West Payakumbuh, East Payakumbuh, and North Payakumbuh. Payakumbuh is characterized by megalithic stones which are found in various places in and around the city that originate from pre-historical eras. The city is also home to traditional Randai which combines martial arts, dance choreography, and music. The Randai show is usually accompanied by the traditional sounds of Talempung and Saluang which produce distinctive Minangkabau songs.



Sawahlunto

An hour's drive from Padang, the capital of West Sumatra Province, to the northeastern suburbs, you will find the road split in two directions. On the left, the road will take you to Lake Singkarak, and to the right - about 95 km from Padang, a beautiful small town adorned with a legacy of the past and hospitality typical of the Minangkabau ethnic group: Sawahlunto. Sawahlunto is known as a city of 'black pearls' that is reminiscent of the once abundant coal which was the city's main product. William Hendrik de Greeve, a Dutch geologist, discovered the site in the early 19th century, and found it to be rich in coal deposits, known as the Black Pearl. So the first Dutch investment in coal mining was carried out here starting in the 19th century, building infrastructure, public facilities, offices, hotels, residential areas, and shops.



Bukittinggi

Many visitors come to Bukittinggi to visit the Sianok Gorge, an extraordinary canyon where giant rock cliffs face, steep trees that grow on it and the dramatic mountains around it make this canyon a stunning sight. Bukittinggi has a cool, refreshing climate due to its height - more than 900 meters above sea level. This is the ideal place to go if you want to go beyond the average tourist trail. Compared to other places in Sumatra, Bukittinggi only accepts a handful of visitors who use the city as a base for nearby climbing or for cultural tours to the Minangkabau highlands. Bukittinggi is a pleasant two-hour drive (90 km) from Padang through the beautiful Anai Valley to Agam Plateau. There are often local buses from Padang to Bukittinggi or cheaper shared minivans that depart from Minang Plaza.



Mount Kerinci

Mount Kerinci is the highest mountain on the island of Sumatra and is very popular among mountain climbers. The closest village and climber base is KersikTuo, near KayuAro, Kerinci. The route is marked by signs, posted at half kilometer intervals. Kerinci Mountain is also known by the name of IndrapuraPeak, GunungMenara, Kurinci and Korinci Volcano. This is one of the favorite mountaineers because the condition of the mountain trail is clear and easy to follow. 7-8 hours drive from Padang or 278 km. If not, you can go to the village of Grit Tuo with a distance of 211 km from Padang or about 5-6 hours drive.



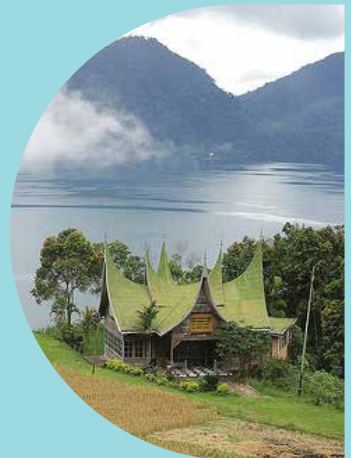
Sianok canyon

Gorge with a beautiful view where majestic Mount Singgalang appears in the background. Sianok canyon has two steep walls facing each other almost vertically, falling on a flat bottom where a river meanders between green rice fields. Located on the outskirts of the hill town of Bukittinggi in the Minangkabau highlands, with a height of about 100 to 120 meters and a canyon that is 15 km long, it separates the city of Bukittinggi and the City of Gadang on the opposite side. The beauty of Sianok can be seen from the Panorama Park in Bukittinggi. Visitors can take a private car or sado / andong (traditional train) from the city center to Panorama Park which is located on Panorama Street while enjoying the cold weather of Bukittinggi.



Maninjau Lake

Lake Maninjau, which means 'to look across' is a volcanic crater lake located 38 km west of Bukittinggi. This lake has a length of 17 km and a width of 8 km and reaches a depth of 480 m in several places. Located at an altitude of 461 m above sea level, the surrounding water is cool and pleasant. A perfect place for adventure, a little relaxation, and to experience the local rural lifestyle by visiting traditional farmers and fishing villages. You can also enjoy the beautiful view of the lake from the height of Lawang Peak, the pine hill park around the lake. Other interesting features include experiencing the road bend 44 which is also known by the locals as Twisting 44 where you can enjoy the fresh air of the forest and rice fields along the road.

A bowl of hot Timlo soup filled with clear broth bombarded with cut chicken fried eggs , sweet boiled eggs , boiled mushrooms, various vegetables, chicken innards, and a sprinkling of crispy fried Asian onions.



Gudeg

This first Jogjakarta specialty food certainly doesn't sound familiar, right? Who doesn't know this particular Jogjafood. Gudeg is Jogja's special food made from young jackfruit cooked with coconut milk. Jogja's distinctive food has a brown color which is usually produced by teak leaves cooked together. Gudeg is usually eaten with rice and served with thick coconut milk sauce (areh), native chicken, eggs, tofu and krecek fried sambal.



Bakpia

You can find Bakpia, green bean cakes in this place. Why does the name contain numbers? That's because in 1980 a new packaging began to appear with trademarks according to house numbers, followed by other Bakpia emergencies with different trademark numbers. The house owner has a house number 25 so, that name is based on their house number. BakpiaPathok 25 has been established for 38 years. Nowadays Bakpia doesn't only sell with original taste. They are enhanced by adding many flavors such as Bakpia Cheese, Bakpia C oklat, BakpiaGreentea, Bakpia Durian and many others.

Merapi Lava Tour

On 25 October 2010 the Merapi volcano erupted lava from the southern and southeast slopes. The eruption carried millions of cubic stones and hot sand. The nearest village fell by heat material and pyroclastic flow. Nowadays, this place is used as a tourist destination. Yes, we call it the Lava tour. We will ride a jeep on Mount Merapi and visit exotic places with beautiful views, Mount Merapi, rivers. A quiet and peaceful place. You can also hear the sounds of grasshoppers, birds and blowing winds. This tour route starts from the Merapi Museum - Mass Grave - Petung Village / Mini Museum - Jambu / Alien Stone Hamlet - Sungai Kuning.



Sultan Palace

The Sultan's Palace known as The Keraton is one of the main heritage buildings in Yogyakarta where the Sultan of Yogyakarta and his family live. This palace is located in the city center and is still used for special occasions and ceremonies, especially coronation. The center of the palace is called the Kencana Ward, which is adjacent to the Prabayeksa Ward, where holy weapons are stored. Visitors can explore the interior of the palace on foot. The palace is open for visitors from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. except for Fridays and Saturdays which close at 11:00 a.m. Closed in the afternoon. Note that there are also special rules that are made to be respected when you visit The Kraton, so make sure you follow them for an unforgettable experience in Yogyakarta



Lawang Sewu

Lawangsewu which means thousand doors is a Dutch colonial building around TuguMuda. It was built as the headquarters of a local railroad company . During World War II, it was used as the headquarters of the Japanese army. The main attraction of LawangSewu is the high stained glass window. The building is currently undergoing restoration even though it is still open to the public. Tour guides are available at the entrance of the building. Although famous for being haunted because of the many executions there during World War II, LawangSewu remains one of the most famous landmarks in Semarang.



Ambarawa Train Museum

Ambarawa Railway Station was built and named the Willem I Railway Station because the Dutch King Willem I ordered its development. There are two types of trains railway running from Ambarawa. The 8.5 foot 4 foot gauge goes through Kedungjati to the northeast, and the 3 foot 6in line goes south to Yogyakarta via Magelang. Ambarawa is the link between the two regions that have different measuring sizes. In this museum you can take an old train from the city of Ambarawa to the city of Secang. At present, the Ambarawa Railway Museum maintains 21 steam locomotives, with four still in operation. Among the steam locomotives are two B25 0-4-2T B2502 / 3, from the original five fleet used by the track about 100 years ago. A B2501 is now preserved in the nearest city park



Keraton Kasunanan Surakarta

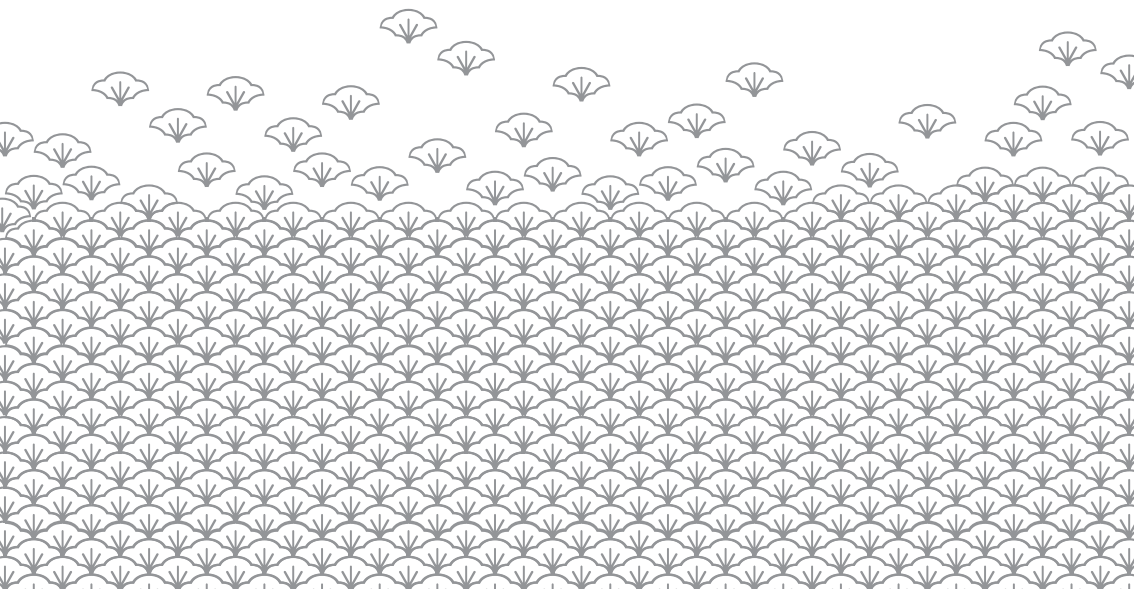
Keraton Kasunanan Surakarta is one of the historical places that was founded in 1744 by Susuhunan Pakubuwono II precisely in the village of Sala (Solo) which at that time was a small port on the banks of the Solo River. Until now, the palace complex is still functioning as the residence of the King and still carry out royal traditions. The Kasunanan Surakarta Palace is located on Jalan Sidikoro, Baluwati, Pasar Kliwon, Surakarta, Central Java. This Solo tourist attraction is open every Monday-Thursday with operational hours at 09.00-14.00 WIB, while on Saturday-Sunday it opens at 09.00-15.00 WIB and Friday is closed.

Museum of Danar Hadi Batik

The Batik Museum is located on Jalan Brigjend Slamet Riyadi, Sriwedari No. 261, Laweyan, Surakarta, Central Java. Tourist attractions featuring various kinds of batik collections in various patterns, from all over the archipelago. Whether in the form of classical to contemporary batik. In this place you can also see how the process of making batik directly.
